Funded by the Government of Canada and other partners, Grand Challenges Canada funds and supports innovators in low- and middle-income countries and Canada to seed and transition to scale their **Bold Ideas with Big Impact®**. For every \$1 dollar that Grand Challenges Canada has invested, we have leveraged \$2 from other partners and investors. The bold ideas Grand Challenges Canada supports integrate science and technology, social and business innovation – known as **Integrated Innovation®**.

One of the largest impact-first investors in Canada, Grand Challenges Canada has funded over **1,300** innovations championed by innovators in over **105 countries**. These innovations are expected to save up to **1.78 million** lives and improve up to **64 million** lives by 2030.
